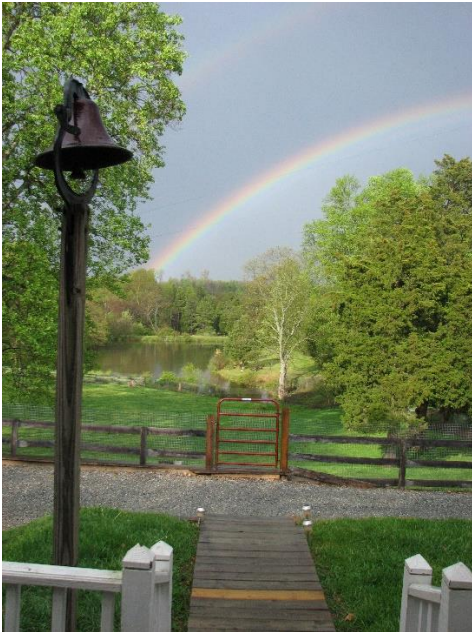

Winter

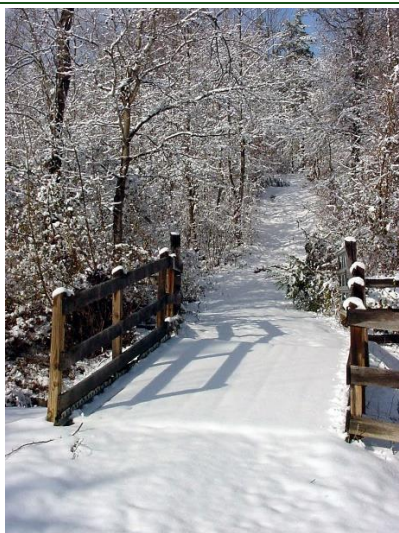
We do get a few inches of snow during winter and it is wonderful to see. Snow generally does last long and within days, it could be gone.

Children love holding new born critters and experiencing farm-life.



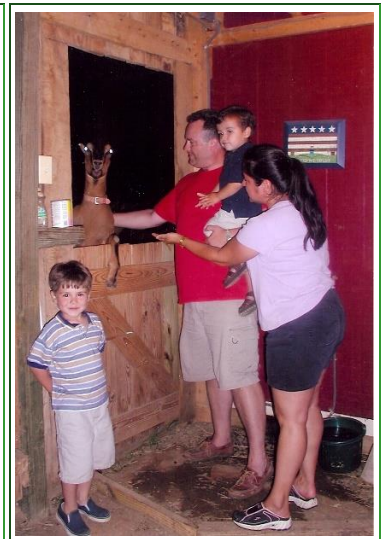
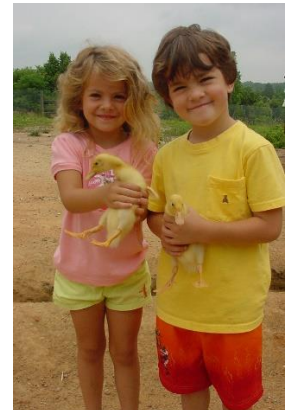
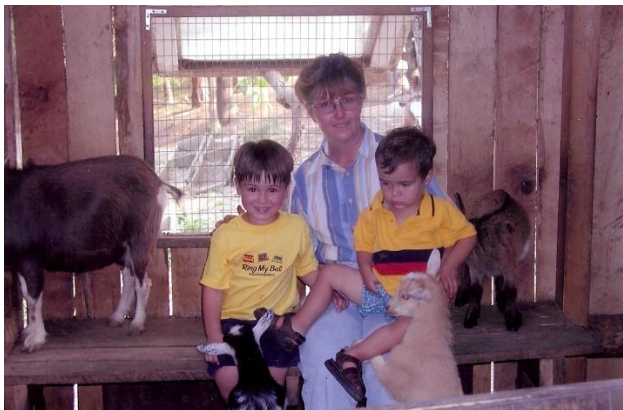
Interacting with the livestock
